

1 Fellowship

Program Overview:

The Ornge Fellowship is an immersive, 12-month full-time clinical program focused on Canadian pre-hospital medicine. It is designed for physicians who have completed specialist training (in emergency medicine, anesthesia, or critical care medicine) and preferably have experience or interest in pre-hospital medicine.

Candidate Experience:

The fellowship begins with a thorough four to six-week induction program, after which the successful fellow gains hands-on experience as an active clinician working alongside Ornge's air and land critical care transport teams. In addition to providing frontline clinical care, the fellow collaborates with transport medicine physicians and paramedics to develop and implement the annual continuing medical education program. The fellow also supports transport medicine physicians at the operations control center by providing on-line medical control for Ornge clinical teams across Ontario. While prior experience in clinical pre-hospital medicine is not required, applicants are encouraged to complete a one-month elective in pre-hospital medicine during their senior years of specialty training. Ideal candidates will have completed specialty training in emergency medicine, anesthesia, or critical care medicine and must be legally entitled to work in Canada. Applicants with relevant pre-hospital experience are strongly encouraged to apply.

Positions and Location:

One fellowship position is available annually.

Base location is Toronto with 1-2 rotations in Northern Ontario bases.

Application Process:

Applications are due by September 30th, 2025, for the January 2027 intake.

Applications must include a CV and cover letter.
